## ACT NOW!

B&L COMPUTER MATCH is looking for an organized group in your school to sponsor the B&L COMPUTER MATCH fund raising activity. With your help, we will prepare an individual computer match list for each person in your school who is willing to participate. Since it costs nothing to participate, most people are excited to get involved.

The matches are selected by the computer which analyzes answers given in response to one of the enclosed questionnaires. Each list contains names of compatible members of the opposite gender, the same gender, or both genders all from your school (as selected by each participant.) As the sponsoring group you have the opportunity to sell these lists after they are printed and make a profit on each list sold. Lists that you do not sell can be returned to us and you will not be charged for them. **YOU CANNOT LOSE MONEY. NO PREPAYMENT IS REQUIRED.**

### YOUR DUTIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **OBTAIN PERMISSION.** A faculty advisor and permission from school authorities is required.
2. **ADVERTISE TO GENERATE ENTHUSIASM.** Inform students well in advance about your computer match plans and let them know it will take about 2 weeks to receive the results. Use bulletins, posters, newspapers and announcements to advertise. (Sample announcements and poster are included in this packet.)
3. **CHOOSE A QUESTIONNAIRE.** Use one of our existing ones (this is the fastest and easiest way to do it) or make up your own questionnaire using questions from our questionnaires. You may make changes on questions but please remember that QUESTION NOS. 1 and 2 **MUST REMAIN THE SAME.** You may also add up to 5 questions (#26-#30) of your own to the existing questionnaire. Each question should have no more than 4 answers and must be numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4. Send us a copy of the questionnaire used. Slight changes can be made to existing questions or you may delete a question and replace it with another. Alternatively, there is an online tool to help with customized questionnaires at <http://www.blmatch.com>.
4. **DUPLICATE** the enclosed answer sheet and questionnaire for the entire student body.
5. **DISTRIBUTE** questionnaires and answer sheets without cost to the entire student body, preferably during home room or during a class period when every student can be reached. Collect answer sheets immediately. **SUCCESS DEPENDS UPON COLLECTING COMPLETED ANSWER SHEETS FROM EVERY STUDENT!!**

6. SEND THE COMPLETED ANSWER SHEETS AND PROCESSING INSTRUCTIONS TO:

B&L COMPUTER MATCH, 4255 S. Buckley Road, #413, Aurora, CO 80013.

We will enter the data into the computer, compute the results, print a special *B&L Computer Match* for each answer sheet received, and return the results to you!! You will receive your results in about 2 weeks if done by mail. Much faster if done electronically.. (It may take a little longer at Valentine's Day --we recommend you mail early if you wish to run it at that time.) Package answer sheets securely in padded mailing bags and reinforced with filament tape. Mail either by UPS or First Class/Priority Mail. If you are in a hurry send by Federal Express, UPS 2nd Day Air or U.S. Express Mail. **DO NOT MAIL BY THIRD CLASS OR FOURTH CLASS.** (Alternatively, you can enter the answer sheet information online at <http://www.blmatch.com> as transmit it electronically. Its more work but its less expensive and generally is more accurate than having us enter the information since you know the students. Results will be available sooner if transmitted electronically. See <http://www.blmatch.com> for details.)

7. FORMS. All necessary forms are enclosed here. Online versions are available at <http://www.blmatch.com> as well as tools to customize the forms. You may copy any of the questionnaires and answer sheet without retyping. Also enclosed is an 8-1/2x11 poster that can be reproduced and put on bulletin boards, etc. On the next page is the B&L COMPUTER MATCH processing instructions form. **THIS FORM MUST BE TRANSMITTED TO B&L COMPUTER MATCH, EITHER BY MAIL, EMAIL, OR VIA THE BLMATCH.COM WEBSITE BEFORE PROCESSING AND MATCHING WILL BEGIN.**

# HELPFUL HINTS

After helping schools sponsor the B&L COMPUTER MATCH for many years, we have discovered two VERY IMPORTANT and HELPFUL hints that will make your computer match fund-raising activity as successful as possible.

**#1** If at all possible, get permission to pass out the questionnaires and answer sheets in home rooms so that ALL students participate and no answer sheets get lost. You will need to work with your principal, but it is well worth the effort. THE ASSISTANCE OF A FACULTY ADVISOR CAN REALLY HELP YOU TO MAKE THESE KIND OF ARRANGEMENTS.

**#2** Sell the results AT SCHOOL where everyone has the opportunity to buy their lists. If you use the B&L COMPUTER MATCH in conjunction with a dance or other activity, it is vitally important that you also sell the lists AT SCHOOL, either before or after the dance.

## REMEMBER THIS:

Once the lists become available, the people in your school will want to buy the lists. We know because we have worked with hundreds of schools like yours.

However, if a student or teacher didn't get to turn in an answer sheet, you won't have a list for them.

Students need to see you selling the lists. Make sure every student you have a list for gets a chance to purchase his or her list. He or she will be disappointed if they don't get a chance.

**DON'T FORGET-- HAVE FUN!! (Who said that making money has to be hard?!)**

## ??? QUESTIONS & ANSWERS!!!

1. *Can we sell our B&L COMPUTER MATCH Lists at a dance or an activity?*

YES! Be sure to also sell the lists during school hours to give everyone an opportunity to buy the results. Remember to allow 2 weeks for processing when planning the activity.

2. *Is the information on our answer sheet used for any other purpose besides COMPUTER MATCHING?*

NO! The information given on answer sheets is used strictly for COMPUTER MATCHING; it is not divulged to anyone outside your school and is destroyed shortly after we receive your payment.

3. *Our students seem less excited about the upcoming B&L Computer Match than we hoped. Is this a bad sign?*

This is common in schools that are running the B&L Computer Match for the first time. The interest level increases dramatically once the results are printed and available for sale. The secret of a successful B&L Computer Match is to get as many answer sheets filled out and returned because – and this is important – a large number of people disinterested when answering the questionnaire will become VERY INTERESTED when the results become available for sale.

4. *What have you found to be the best way to distribute questionnaires and answer sheets?*

Despite the availability of electronic devices, the best way stills seems to be to distribute paper questionnaires and answer sheets to the entire school at once in home room and giving them 15 minutes

to fill them out there and then collect the paper answer sheets. This is only possible of course when the school administration is on board. Allowing students to leave with questionnaires and answer sheets in the hopes they return them later results in less answer sheets.

5. *Can we combine with other schools?*

Yes! If you are a small school and can make arrangements, you can combine with another school. If you are a large school, you may have a combined computer match with another school after both schools have completed the B&L COMPUTER MATCH in both schools. Please write or call us if you are thinking about combining with another school.

6. *Can teachers fill out answer sheets and participate in the B&L COMPUTER MATCH?*

YES - Teachers should leave the grade level space blank on the ANSWER SHEET.

7. *Can we match 9th and 10th grades in one group and 11th and 12th grades in another group?*

YES! When you send in your answer sheets, put them in separate groups with specific instructions that you want each group matched independently. However, even if you keep them in one group (recommended), any student's matches will be within a range of two grades. For example a person in grade 10 would be matched with people in grades 9, 10 and 11 but not with 7, 8, or 12.

8. *Should we announce this activity over the intercom?*

YES! We have found this to be very effective. Please note examples below:

FLASH--Word has just come in from (Name of High School) on the B&L COMPUTER MATCH. It has just been discovered that the cost to you is only \_\_\_\_ . For this very small amount you will receive your own personal list of ten people you are compatible with. But first...you must fill out the questionnaire. There is one waiting for you in (homeroom, office, etc.). DON'T DELAY...PUT SOME ZIP IN YOUR DAY! Get matched! We now return you to your regularly scheduled program.

MAY WE HAVE YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE!!! Something special is coming up. The B&L COMPUTER MATCH! You won't want to miss this activity. Get your questionnaire today in room \_\_\_\_ . Be sure to turn in your answer sheet. There is no cost to participate. Later, if you like, you may buy your list of 10 names especially picked by the computer to be compatible with you.

IS LIFE A DRAG? Want to meet new people you have something in common with? GET MATCHED by B&L COMPUTER MATCH. Pick up your questionnaire in \_\_\_\_ . Turn in your answer sheet and soon you will have 10 names picked by the computer especially for you.

9. *Can we choose the price we sell the lists??*

YES, within reason, generally from \$2-\$5. \$3 is the recommended price. Contact B&L COMPUTER MATCH for if you need advice or have questions about pricing.

10. *We have a computer and the internet at our school. Why should we use the B&L COMPUTER MATCH instead of doing everything ourselves?*

Producing a service comparable to the B&L Computer Match is no small task. It takes thoroughly tested computer programs. Being the "guinea-pig" for a new computer program is no fun at all.

B&L COMPUTER MATCH provides copyrighted questionnaires and advertising material to get you going fast. Hopefully, you understand the advantage of using PROFESSIONALS to process your surveys (answer sheets). This allows us to do what we do best: process your answer sheets quickly and accurately. It allows you to do what you can do best: distribute the questionnaires and answer sheets and collect the money. This is a partnership and it works well when each partner does its respective job well!

## QUESTIONNAIRE AND ANSWER SHEET

### Master Copies

Choose **ONE** questionnaire out of the six provided. Use the answer sheet form provided. **MAKE A COPY OF YOUR QUESTIONNAIRE AND ANSWER SHEET FOR EACH STUDENT IN YOUR SCHOOL.** Since an answer sheet only takes 1/2 of a page, there are two answer sheets per page. This means you only need to copy half as many sheets, and then cut them in half. For example, if you have 1000 students in your school, you will need to copy 1000 questionnaires and 500 of the answer sheets form. After you cut the 500 answer sheets in half, you will have 1000 questionnaires and 1000 answer sheets.

In addition to the grade level, a homeroom or locker number may be included in the 5-box field located to the right of the grade level box. This is optional and may be left blank. If you desire to use this option please label underneath the 5-box field, before copying, what you want the field to be (home room, locker, etc.). B&L COMPUTER MATCH discourages the use of phone numbers; however, if phone numbers are desired, draw an 8-box field on the answer sheet and label it PHONE.
